Graves moved to Denver in April, 2023 from New York. In August 2024 she opened a Studio/Gallery at 900 Santa Fe Drive, Studio B. Graves has a BA from Metropolitan State University and MA from New York University. She was an adjunct Assistant Professor of Art at New York University and also taught at Sarah Lawrence College, Pratt Manhattan and the International Center of Photography in NYC. Graves was the Director of the Advanced Digital Print Studio at NYU between 2005 - 2012. Graves taught the large format digital print and artists methods using the computer, formulating and devising digital techniques and an expert command of photographic work. She has shown work in New York, Long Island, Philadelphia, Virginia, Miami, Colorado, Havana Viejo, Cuba, the Czech Republic, Italy and South Korea.
